The Parma Board of Zoning Appeals met on Tuesday, November 15, 2022 at 6:35pm and PROPOSED TO VARY, subject to the provisions of amended Ordinances Section 1153.02 (confirmation or rejection by Council within forty days of receipt of this notice) FOR THE APPLICANT Dean Dipiero Law acting agent for Euerle Group, LLC. PPN 442-01-003. After discussion Mr. John Yurkiw made the following recommendations: "I make a motion to recommend to Council to grant Dean Dipiero Law acting agent for Euerle Group, LLC of 5301 Hauserman Rd, Parma, Ohio 44130 has requested variances of the City of Parma Codified Ordinances of Section 1153.02 Single Family House District, no building or premises shall be erected, used, arranged or designed to be used, in whole or in part, for other than single-family detached dwellings. The applicant is requesting a variance to operate an indoor/outdoor event and game center at a parcel zoned single-family. This variance would result in a commercial business being operated in the single-family residential district. PPN 442.01-003. The following stipulations to be added: A) No physical connection or building addition ever be constructed allowing egress and ingress between the buildings; B) The hours of operation of the gun range never be extended beyond the current hours of operations so as to coincide with operations and business at the event center; and C) No advertisements or discounts be offered or displayed at the event center for the gun range."

Mrs. Michelle Green 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Mr. Patrick O'Connor, Mr. John Yurkiw, and Mr. George Mastrobuono votes yes to grant the variances. Mr. George Ziefle had to refrain from his vote, he is an employee of the gun range. Also be it noted that variance once granted, shall not be withdrawn or changed unless there is a change of circumstances or if after the expiration of six months no substantial construction is done in accordance with the terms and condition for which such variance was granted. In which case the Building Commissioner shall give notice in writing, and thirty days thereafter the variances will be deemed null and void, and all regulations governing such premises in question shall revert back to those in effect before the variance was granted.
