Councilman Crossman - Curios where this comes from and we have not had a discussion about the Governors budget as it relates to our budget. So just curios if I can get an explanation?

Councilman Brochetti - I will just very briefly. I introduced this legislation at the request of the Treasurer and his department. This Resolution specifically outlines two things that is damaging financial aspects. Well there are a lot of things that are in this proposed budget that we have not discussed that will also be something that I would oppose, such as the education. I know that received a lot things where teachers would have to intern the business, but this specifically focuses on two financial aspects of it and it was on the request of the treasurer.

Treasurer Mastroianni - To Councilman Crossman, and first of all, I would like to thank Councilman Brochetti for sponsoring this. Probably most of the city and towns in the state are opposing this. We sent somebody to ODA, which is our county wide tax organization, and every city is opposing the state budget. On our end it's because what I spoke about earlier in our budget process is, they are trying basically to take our business income tax collections away from us. They want to take a portion of it now and than once they do that you know again like I said when do you get your money, do you get all your money, how much are they going to charge you now? Then charge you more in the future and then what comes next? So, I went to Councilman Brochetti and showed him numerous city Resolutions and he decided to sponsor it. And that is where it came from.

Anthony Zarlinga, 7805 Manorford Dr. - State that Manorford Dr. has been in need of repaving for the past four years. There is a section that ties into the City of Parma Heights that is coming out in chunks. Asked if the city could take a look at his street?
